There are 12 months in the year. The months are January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December. The year is divided into four seasons of three months each. These seasons are spring, summer, autumn or fall, and winter. The spring months are March, April, and May. The summer months are June, July, and August. The autumn or fall months are September, October, and November. The winter months are December, January, and February. (1) The seasons commence on the 21st and end on the 20th day of the month. January, March, May, July, August, October, and December have 31 days each. April, June, September, and November have 30 days each. February has 28 days, except every fourth year, called leap year, when it has one day more. The abbreviated or short forms for writing the months are as follows: Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr. (May, June, and July are not abbreviated), Aug., Sept., Oct., Nov., Dec.

The first day of January is New Year's Day, and it is observed as a holiday in all of the States and in Washington City, the capital of the Nation. (2) February 12 is the birthday of Abraham Lincoln, and in a great many States it is a legal holiday. February 22 is Washington's Birthday, and it is universally observed as a holiday throughout the United States. March 4 is the day on which, every fourth year, the President of the United States is inaugurated. It is a holiday in Washington City in that year. (3) May 30 is called Memorial or Decoration Day, when exercises in memory of the soldier dead are held, and is a holiday in most of the States. The Fourth of July or Independence Day is observed as a holiday in every part of the United States. The first Monday in September has been named by Congress Labor Day.
